We will focus on number and calculation this half term. We will learn about the value of digits up to 10,000,000 and 3 decimal places. We will order and compare numbers, looking for patterns and sequences. We will learn to use formal written methods to add, subtract, multiply and divide. We will apply our learning to solve worded and open-ended problems.

We will keep aiming for our Masters of Multiplication. In UKS2 we need to know all times tables up to 12 x 12 with related division facts.
