

Maths

We will learn to count forwards and backwards in 1s, 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s up to 100. We will count, order, estimate and compare sets of objects accurately. We will learn to write these numbers correctly. We will find missing numbers in sequences and continue sequences independently. Year 2 children will learn to partition 2 digit numbers into tens and units. We will learn to add and subtract practically, mentally and using a number line. We will solve a range of problems involving measurements such as length and mass. We will start practising for our Masters of Multiplication.

We will be reading Jack and the Beanstalk. We will use phonics to spell words in our own sentences. We will learn to use capital letters at the beginning of sentences and for proper nouns. We will learn to use full stops correctly. We will write our own diaries, stories, instructions and character descriptions. We will learn to identify and use nouns, adjectives and joining words (and, but, so, because etc) in sentences.

We will practise forming our letters properly, positioning them on the line correctly and holding our pencils comfortably.
