Once you have watched the video try to spend some time in your garden or looking outside your window, stay really quiet and see how many different birds you can hear. You could try listening at different times of the day- does it make a difference to what you hear ? Then see how many different birds you can spot over a few days- a

good way to do this is to keep a short diary and each day look outside or go outside and draw some of the birds you see- try to take a photo for you to copy- you could then use the photo to help identify the bird .
