<p><i>Intent</i></p>	<p>At Sandy Lane , the children are taught to develop an interest in learning other languages in a way that is enjoyable and stimulating. We use a range of resources to offer a relevant, broad and vibrant French curriculum. We aim to embed the skills of listening, speaking , reading and writing to enable the children to use and apply their French learning in a variety of contexts and lay the foundations for future language learning.</p> <p>The intent is that all pupils will develop a genuine interest and positive curiosity about foreign languages. Learning French will also offer pupils the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of other cultures and the world around them with a better awareness of self, others and cultural differences. They will be working towards becoming life-long language learners.</p>
<p><i>Implementation</i></p>	<p>Our MFL curriculum is designed to progressively develop children's skills in languages, through KS2</p> <p>Teachers deliver MFL through using a range of resources, including films, songs, role play and games.</p> <p>Children progressively acquire , use and apply a growing bank of vocabulary organised around topics.</p> <p>Children are encouraged and supported to develop their speaking and listening skills through conversational work, singing activities and games. Children will also have the opportunities to look at aspects of the French culture- including food and festivals to immerse themselves in the language and improve cultural awareness.</p> <p>As confidence grows children record their work through a range of tailored activities to ensure all children can access the MFL curriculum that is outlined in the National Curriculum.</p> <p>Children will also have opportunities to look at aspects of the French culture- including food and festivals to immerse themselves in the language and improve cultural awareness.</p> <p>Teachers use highly effective assessment for learning through all lessons and regularly complete assessment grids to monitor progress and inform planning.</p>
<p><i>Impact</i></p>	<p>As a result of our MFL curriculum</p> <p>Children will be able to recognise and apply key vocabulary and will be challenged in a range of speaking and listening, reading and writing activities. Children will start at basic noun and article level and be able to formulate a short phrase.</p> <p>Children will be able to hold short conversations and personalise their phrases.</p>
