## Maths Intentions:

Introduce numbers to 10 in 5 Minute Maths, from week 2 to 6 then consolidate. Use subitising flashcards to make each number e.g. 4 and 2 make 6.

Wk 1 - Consolidate to 5, counting to 10

Wk 2 - (6) Make 5 using different apparatus - frames, part-whole. - total of two groups

Wk 3 - (7) Sorting groups & make patterns

Wk 4 - (8) Comparing groups, less/more

Wk 5 - (9) ordering numbers, 1 more/1 less to 5

Wk 6 - (10) School day, morning/afternoon/evening & Measuring Time - how many jumps in a minute?

Wk 7 - Number bonds to 5 recall.
