Develop an awareness of the past, using common words and phrases relating to the passing of time.

Key Stage 1

Samuel Peyps

Research about the life of Samuel Peyps using different resources. Look at the feature of a letter and write a diary entry from the perspective of a child during the Great Fire of London.

Once Upon A Time Great Fire of London

Look at what happened during the Great Fire of London. Where did it start? Sequence the main events and create a timeline.

Castles

Compare the castle from medieval times to the modern homes of today- How have the castles influenced large modern homes?

Time Travellers

Victorians

Learn about the reign of Queen Victoria.
Compare the poor and rich lives of Victorians.
Compare Victorian school days to ours.
How did Victorian industries influence our modern world ? Trip to the Industrial Museum.

Greek Gods & Temples

Research and describe the Greek Gods.
Study the Temple of Zeus, Olympius and Artemis- compare the features and draw and build models.
Compare local buildings- Lister Mill, Salts Mill, Saltaire church to the temples.- were any features taken from the Greek temples ?
Olympics- the story behind the Olympics .

Stone Age

Describe changes in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age- Case study- Skara Brae.
Study and understand the life of hunter gatherers in the Neolithic period- Trip to Nell bank.
To locate and describe Stonehenge- identify the key features.

Ancient Greeks

To study a period of British History beyond 1066.
Key dates for the ancient Greek period.
Learn about a typical day as a Greek servant.
